The expert will be part of the CADRI assessment team, which will also include selected UNDAC members.

The expert should meet the following requirements:

- Educational background in environmental sciences;
- Work experience in the field of environmental assessments, with a focus on capacity assessments;
- Ability to integrate environmental considerations across disciplines, and specifically into disaster risk reduction and emergency management;
- Completed training course on Environment and Emergencies (of stand-by partner, UNDAC system, UN Environment/OCHA Joint Unit response partner and/or other organization) is an asset;
- Ability to coordinate with international and local agencies involved in disaster risk management;
- Team skills required for working in a multi-disciplinary, multi-national team in field conditions of hardship with an ability to assume authority as and when needed;
- Fluency in Spanish (required);
- Availability for additional follow-up, collaboration and editing of mission report for up to 4 weeks after the official mission deadline as required.
